

TUITION RATES FOR THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

It is our **goal at Saint Ephrem School** to provide our students with a high **quality and affordable** Catholic education. To that end, after meeting with our Parish Finance Committee, we are pleased to announce a **modest but equitable tuition** increase for the next school year. These increases will insure the **on-going, financial security** of Saint Ephrem School.

Some important facts for your consideration:

The **actual cost to our parish** of educating each child is **\$4,620**.

Our Parish will **continue to cover** more than a **one third of the cost for one child** and a much **larger subsidy for two or more children**.

We are asking our **families to pay less than 2/3** of the cost for one child and **even less** for two or more.

Tuition Rates for the 2017-2018 School Year

Two children	\$5,000	\$500
Three or more children	\$5,950	\$595

<u>Grades K-8 Out of Parish</u>	Tuition	Monthly
One child	\$4,200	\$420
Two children	\$7,500	\$750

Please note:

St. Ephrem School receives tuition assistance as a result of EITC and/or OSTC. This assistance comes from four organizations: BLOCS, Bridges Education Foundation, Foundation for Catholic Education and the Henkels Foundation. During this current school year, we were able to assist 69 families!

To apply for any additional assistance, a family **MUST be registered on SmartAid** (which is not the same as Smart Tuition). A family will be ineligible for assistance if they have not applied through SmartAid. **No exceptions** will be made by any member of the Rectory or school staff in fairness to everyone.
